

Beaded Paris Flags

Supplies:

Blue beads
Red beads
White beads
Satin cord
Toothpicks
Scissors
Glue

Instructions

1. Select a flag pattern to duplicate.
 2. Using 12" of satin cord, starting at the far right column of the flag pattern, string three beads and bring them to the middle of the cord.
 3. String the middle column of beads on the right side of the original three beads.
 4. String the cord on the left side of the original three beads though the same three beads in reverse order.
 5. Weave the final column in the same way.
 6. Bring the ends together and tie off at the bottom.
 7. Coat the end 1/2" of the toothpick with glue and slide it into the final row of beads, let dry.
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
