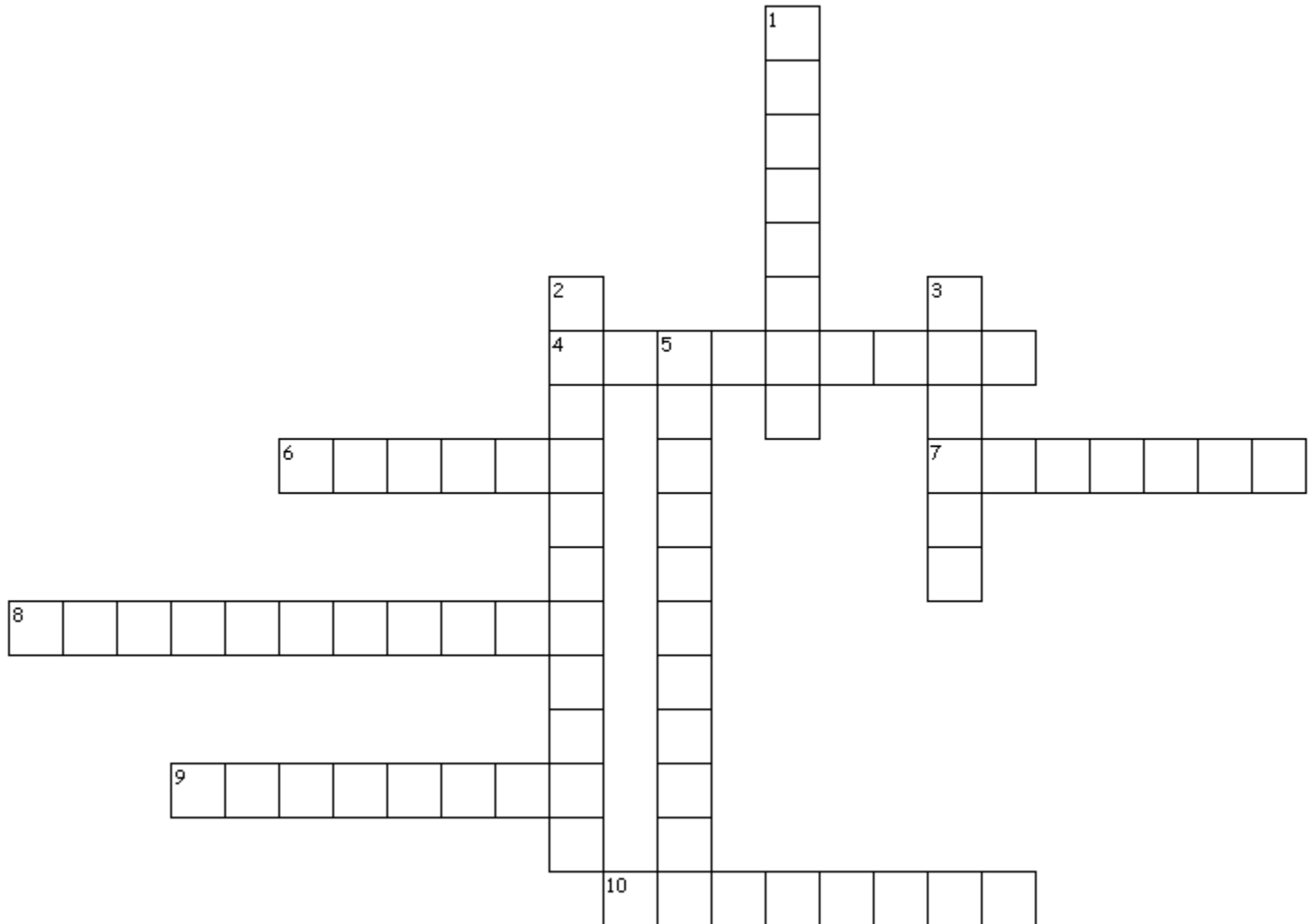

- #10 a slowly moving mass or river of ice formed by the accumulation and compaction of snow on mountains or near the poles
