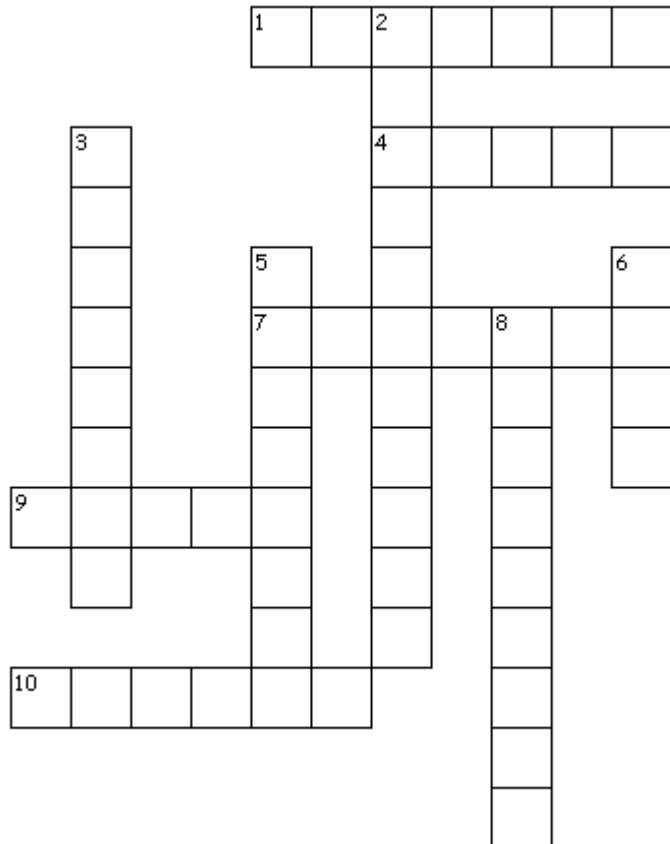
#2 British explorer who first recorded European contact with the Hawaiian islands.
