#5 This park was originally created by Henry the Eighth for hunting.

#6 The great clock tower of the Houses of Parliament in London and its bell.

#7 The capital of the United Kingdom, in southeastern England on the Thames River.

#8 Relatively new attraction that has been giving everyone a spectacular view of London since it opened on December 31, 1999.

#9 An inner London borough that contains the Houses of Parliament and many government offices.

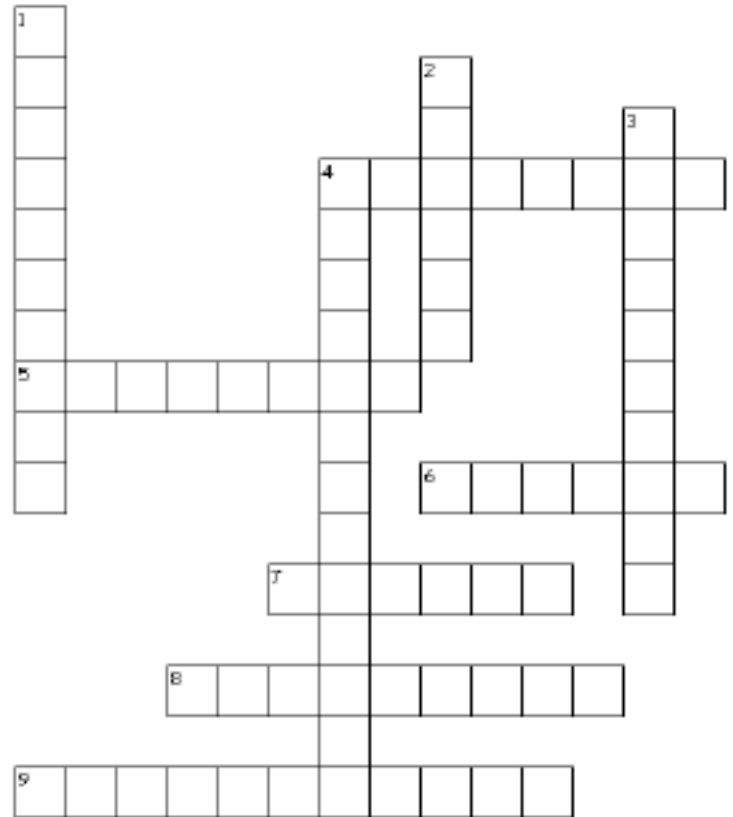
### Down

#1 Home to the Queen of England, Elizabeth the Second, and the rest of the Royal Family.

#2 A river in southern England that flows 210 miles east from the Cotswolds in Gloucestershire through London to the North Sea.

#3 A Yeoman Warder or Yeoman of the Guard in the Tower of London.

#4 A fortress by the Thames River just east of the City of London. The oldest part, the White Tower, was begun in 1078. It was later used as a state prison, and is now open to the public as a repository of ancient armor and weapons, and of the Crown jewels.
